



2021 Event Guidelines During Coronavirus Pandemic

Prior to your JH Outback event:

- JH Outback is committed to doing everything possible for a healthy and safe environment. Guests participate in a JH Outback retreat at their own risk and will be required to sign a release agreement (included with online registration) prior to the event to acknowledge their willing participation given the coronavirus risks.
- All JH Outbacks will comply with local, state and federal health requirements. Based on the evolving local and state regulations, there will likely be more restrictions than the general ones listed below. These extra restrictions will be communicated to guests two weeks prior to the start of the JH Outback event.

During your JH Outback event:

- The gathering spaces have been reduced to 50% occupancy. We will follow any further guidelines required in each city.
- Individuals/families should be spaced six feet apart when seated and should practice proper physical distancing from other individuals/families. For Big Top seating, paired seats may be spread throughout the area in assigned seats that don't change throughout the weekend.
- As much as possible limit items that can be passed to or between attendees who are not family members.
- Items used to distribute food or beverages must be disposable.
- A thorough cleaning and disinfection of frequently contacted surfaces should be conducted prior to and following gatherings and use of facilities.
